Don't miss their scrumptious breakfast dishes with ingredients for the meat lover or enjoy flavorful vegetarian options that include French toast, pancakes, and their delicious veggie scramble.

Fruit Ala Cart: A long-time festival tradition, Fruit Ala Cart provides delicious treats in a rainbow of flavors. They offer banana, coconut, strawberry, and mango frozen cream bars, frozen dipped bananas, and their vegan frozen fruit bars include cherry, pomegranate, lime, strawberry, and watermelon. Everything can be dipped in chocolate and/or smothered in nuts, and always comes with smiles all around.

India Gourmet: Delicious, authentic Indian cuisine. Naan Wraps or Rice Bowls filled with lamb, chicken, or vegan selections of spinach, eggplant or mixed veggies. Dinner-time temptations include combo plates. Sides and snacks are also on the menu.
