Breakfast is a special time around camp, and the original "Sing for Your Breakfast" is a favorite Strawberry tradition. The Breakfast Club combines live on-stage performances from fellow campers (who literally sing for their breakfast!) and a cheerful dining hall ambience. Delicious food will be available or bring your own.

Sign-ups are taken the day before the show, at the Hog Ranch Radio tent, starting at 1:00pm. Doors open, and the show goes live on The Hog at 7:00am! Whether you enjoy the broadcast back at camp on the radio, or in person, The Breakfast Club is a great way to start your festival day!

Fatty Eggroll: New for 2019, a delicious Asian-style menu, which includes pad Thai, vegetable spring rolls, or a hearty vegetable stir-fry with peanut or curry sauce, served ala cart or in a combo.

Fruit Ala Cart: Serving fruit and cream bars in a rainbow of flavors as well as frozen bananas. For extra deliciousness everything offered here can be dipped in chocolate and nuts.

India Gourmet: Delicious and authentic Indian cuisine returns with a mouth-watering selection of meat, vegetarian, and vegan meals and sides. Dinner time temptations include rice bowls, naan wraps, samosas, or combo plates complemented with mango lassi or chai tea.

Krepalicious: Specialty crepes are fresh, local, organic, and can be made both vegan and gluten-free. Featured sweet toppings include strawberries, chocolate, and berry jam, and savory entrées such as the Keltic Breakfast, Bella Pesto, or Ham & Cheese will satisfy every appetite.

Lazy Dog Confections: Local Grass Valley favorites return with their very special house-made ice cream bars, floats, sandwiches, cones, and cups along with a variety of chilled treats including frozen hot chocolate, Italian ice, N.Y. cheesecake, and so much more.

The Nacho Mama: Enjoy nachos anytime as a snack or a meal. Using local ingredients whenever possible, The Nacho Mama serves organic, non-GMO, gluten-free chips with a variety of toppings. Choose among BBQ, tropical, pesto, veggie, vegan, traditional, or dessert nachos.

Pasta Prego: Offerings include New York style pizza by the slice, gluten-free pizzas, lasagna or spaghetti dinners, garlic fries, gourmet salad, and garlic bread. Add pesto drizzle or balsamic dressing and finish with a piece of chocolate chip cookie pizza.
