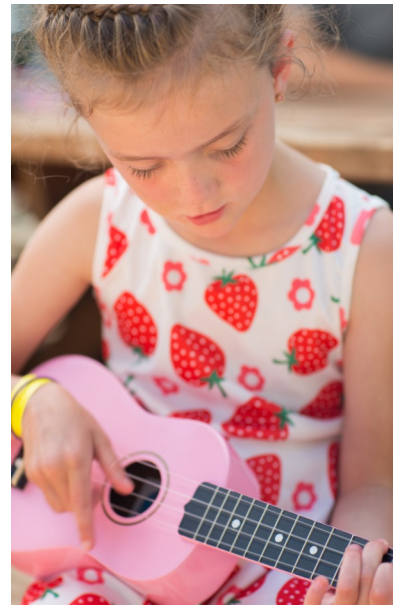

- ◆ Your festival ticket includes a camping spot; please alert any staff member with a radio if you need help finding a place to camp.
- ◆ We always choose to leave the Nevada County Fairgrounds in better condition than when we arrived.
- ◆ Recycle! Recycling stations are located throughout the festival.
- ◆ Practice water conservation by limiting your showers to the "Strawberry 3-Minute Shower."
- ◆ Reuse! Eliminate plastic by bringing your own refillable water bottle.

- Water bottle, plate, cup, cutlery
- Instruments for jamming
- Bike Helmet* (Required for under 18)

POLICIES

- ◆ No firearms or weapons allowed.
- ◆ No fires, open flames, or charcoal cooking allowed.
- ◆ The speed limit throughout camp is 5 MPH.
- ◆ Motorized vehicles are not allowed in camp.
- ◆ No bicycles, etc. allowed on the Music Meadow or in the food court.
- ◆ No pets. Only bona fide service animals are permitted.
- ◆ Quiet generators are permitted to run from 10am to 2pm daily.
- ◆ Do not dump gray water on the ground.
- ◆ Smoking and vaping are permitted in designated areas only.
- ◆ Keep access roads clear and observe all festival boundaries.
- ◆ No swimming, wading, dumping of trash or debris into the NID ditches or Lion's Lake.
- ◆ Frogging is not allowed.
- ◆ Strawberry Music, Inc. is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- ◆ No sales or solicitation without written permission from Strawberry Music, Inc.
- ◆ Strawberry Music, Inc. reserves the right to refuse service to anyone.

COMMAND POST (CP)

- ◆ CP is the headquarters for safety, security, and medical services available 24/7 during the festival.
- ◆ Rude, offensive, unsafe, or abusive behavior will not be tolerated. Please notify Security staff immediately if a situation develops that requires assistance.
- ◆ Sierra Nevada Memorial Hospital is close by in the event of a medical emergency.

ON THE MUSIC MEADOW

Seating is first come, first serve.

"The Strawberry Stroll"

Seating in front of the stage on the Music Meadow

- ◆ The Strawberry Stroll facilitates the placing of the chairs in front of the stage. The Strawberry Stroll line begins forming daily at 7am at the entrance to the Music Meadow. At 8am The Stroll crew will begin guiding you to personally place a maximum of 4 chairs.
- ◆ To ensure good viewing from the audience, we enforce a chair size requirement in the Stroll Seating:
In full upright position, chair backs must be no taller than 32" from the top of the chair to the ground and there must be 10" or less from the bottom of the seat to the ground.
 (No chaise lounges or hook-back chairs.)
- ◆ Any unoccupied chair is open for use by anyone until the owner arrives. (If you do not want to share your chair, please take it with you when you leave the seating area.)

General Seating & Dancing Area

Taller chairs are allowed in General Seating which starts behind the Strawberry Stroll seating and is in line with the soundboard. Dancing is allowed in the designated areas on both sides of the Strawberry Stroll seating.
