

## 2025 Spring & Fall Festivals Entrance Plan

## ALL ATTENDEES:

- 1. <u>CHECK YOUR TICKET</u> FOR ENTRY DAY, TIME, AND GATE.
- 2. DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY THOSE WHO ARRIVE EARLY WILL BE LINED UP TO ENTER LAST.
- 3. <u>DO NOT PARK OR LINE UP</u> OUTSIDE FAIRGROUNDS.
- 4. <u>APPROACH ENTRY GATES WITH CAUTION</u> THE 5 MPH SPEED LIMIT WILL BE ENFORCED.
- 5. <u>SIGNS AND/OR STAFF</u> WILL BE PRESENT TO DIRECT YOU WHEN YOU ARRIVE.
- 6. <u>CONTACT THE OFFICE IN ADVANCE</u> IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS OR NEED ASSISTANCE.

### Camping Ticket Holders:

Enter through drive-through Gate 1 and proceed to the Box Office where staff will greet you to exchange your ticket for a wristband and festival program. Once everyone in your vehicle is banded, you will be directed to enter the campground through Gate 4 via McCourtney Road. Notify Box Office staff if you would like help finding a place to camp. Campers must exit the Nevada County Fairgrounds by 10:00 am on Monday. See back for festival-specific information about Pre-Banding if your ticket allows camping the night before Main Stage entertainment begins.

#### 1-Day Ticket Holders:

Enter through drive-through Gate 1 and proceed to the Box Office where staff will greet you to exchange your ticket for a wristband and festival program. Continue to Day Parking and then enter the Music Meadow through walk-through Gate 1. The fee for Day Parking is included in the price of your ticket and allows for same day re-entry. 1-Day ticket holders must exit the grounds and vacate Day Parking by midnight each night.

#### Box Office (Located inside drive-through Gate 1):

- Will-Call is available for pick-up 24 hours daily with photo I.D.
- Box Office staff can assist with lost tickets.
- Available ticket types (including Child and Teen tickets) can be purchased during Box Office business hours from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm daily.

#### Set-Up Staff:

Crew members working before Thursday, May 22nd (SPRING) and Friday, October 17th (FALL) enter Gate 4 during Staff Check-In hours (see back). Those arriving before or after Staff Check-In hours should coordinate with their crew leader.

#### Vendors:

Vendors enter Gate 4 during Staff Check-In hours (see back). Those arriving before or after Staff Check-In hours should coordinate with their crew leader.

#### Festival & Tear Down Staff:

Crew members working during or after the festival enter drive-through Gate 1. See details about Pre-Banding on the back.

Spring 2025 Festival:
Box Office Hours (Gate 1): Open 24 HR/day from 8:00 am Thursday, May 22nd until 8:00 pm on Sunday, May 25th.
<u>Staff Check-In Hours (Gate 4)</u> : Open 8:00 am - 7:00 pm, Monday, May 19th—Wednesday, May 21st.
Pre-Banding (Gate 1): Every person in the vehicle (ages 7 and up) must have the appropriate 5-Day or 5-Night Camping ticket
in-hand to participate in Pre-Banding on Wednesday, May 21st.
⇒ 5-Day Camping - Pre-banding starts at 10:30 am for entry at noon
⇒ STAFF 5-Day Camping - Pre-banding starts at 10:30 am for entry at noon
⇒ 5-Night Camping - Pre-banding starts at 1:30 pm for entry at 3:00 pm
Do not arrive early. Please approach the Fairgrounds with caution and consideration for others as you enter drive-through Gate 1. Signage and staff will be present to direct you into a lane where your ticket will be exchanged for a wristband and program. Once everyone is banded, you will be directed to enter the campground through Gate 4 via McCourtney Road.
<b>Staff Pre-Banding</b> : Family of staff arriving in the same car on Wednesday, May 21st must have a 5-Day or 5-Night Camping ticket in-hand to participate in Pre-Banding. Confirmed crew members may purchase this ticket type by contacting the office.

Staff Check-In Hours (Gate 4): Open 8:00 am - 7:00 pm, Tuesday October 14th—Thursday, October 16th.
Pre-Banding: Every person in the vehicle (ages 7 and up) must have the appropriate 4-Day or 4-Night Camping ticket in-hand to participate in pre-banding.
→ <b>4-Day Camping</b> - Pre-banding starts at 10:30 am for entry at noon
⇒ STAFF 4-Day Camping - Pre-banding starts at 10:30 am for entry at noon
⇒ 4-Night Camping - Pre-banding starts at 1:30 pm for entry at 3:00 pm
